Tristan Choat is the youngest bowler to roll a 300 at age 17y 5m 11d on 11/11/02
On 11-18-13 John Bogacki Jr (812), Steve Bergan (804), Troy Morton (803) did not
win a High Game pot between them.
Jordan Richard became the 2nd bowler to have 800 (804) on first night (8/26/13)
Cameron Touchette became the 3rd bowler to have 800 (802) on first night (1/18/16)
Phil Watson rolled the first ever b-t-b 300 games (834) on 4/8/13 at Red Bird Lanes
Shawn Nickles was the 2nd to do it (855) on 1/9/16 at Camelot Bowl. He also rolled a
first game 300 on the next time at Camelot on 2/6/16 for 3 in a row in same house
Josh McClain (12-04-17) is the most recent of at least five bowlers to bowl a 300 in their
only game of the night.

Oh What A Start:

Don Griffin had a first night in league that may never be topped. On 11-13-06, bowling
as a substitute, he rolled 840 (300 299 241). The following is a list of records he hit:
First to roll 300 first game in league, first to roll an 800+ first series in league, first to

roll 300 299 to start a series (any series), most strikes to start a series (23), first time 2 left handers rolled 800s same night (Lay had 836 for second, thus having the highest 2nd place series). It was also the only time Don bowled in the league that season. (Don and Jay Bradshaw are the only bowlers to roll 300 299 back to back)

A Season To Forget: Joe Langlitz set a record in the 96-97 season by having a season high 3 game series of 564. It is the "lowest" high series for a bowler with 50+ games. Don Doole has the 2nd lowest high series with 592 for 54 games in 97-98.
